## Law #1

Chapter 12.78 Registration of Bicycles (Madison)

Registration and Licensing of Bicycles.

No person shall operate a bicycle upon any public way within the City of Madison unless said bicycle shall have been properly registered by the City of Madison as hereinafter provided, or shall have a valid current registration in another municipality.

All bicycles must be registered.

## Law #2

Section 10.32.020 Manner of operation restricted in Sun Prairie

No bicycle shall be allowed to proceed in any street in the city by inertia or momentum with the feet of the rider removed from the bicycle pedals. No rider of a bicycle shall remove both hands from the handlebars or practice any trick or fancy riding in any street in the city nor shall any bicycle rider carry or ride any other person so that two persons are on the bicycle at one time, unless a seat is provided for a second person.

You are not allowed to ride your bike in these ways:

- Feet must stay on pedals when you are moving.
- Both hands must be on the handles when riding.
- No bike tricks allowed in the city.
- Two people cannot ride on one bike unless they both have seats on the bike.

## Law #3

347.489(2) Manner of operation restricted in Wisconsin

No person may operate a bicycle, motor bicycle, or electric personal assistive mobility device upon a highway, bicycle lane, or bicycle way unless it is equipped with a brake in good working condition, adequate to control the movement of and to stop the bicycle, motor bicycle, or electric personal assistive mobility device whenever necessary.

Your bicycle must have a working brake.
